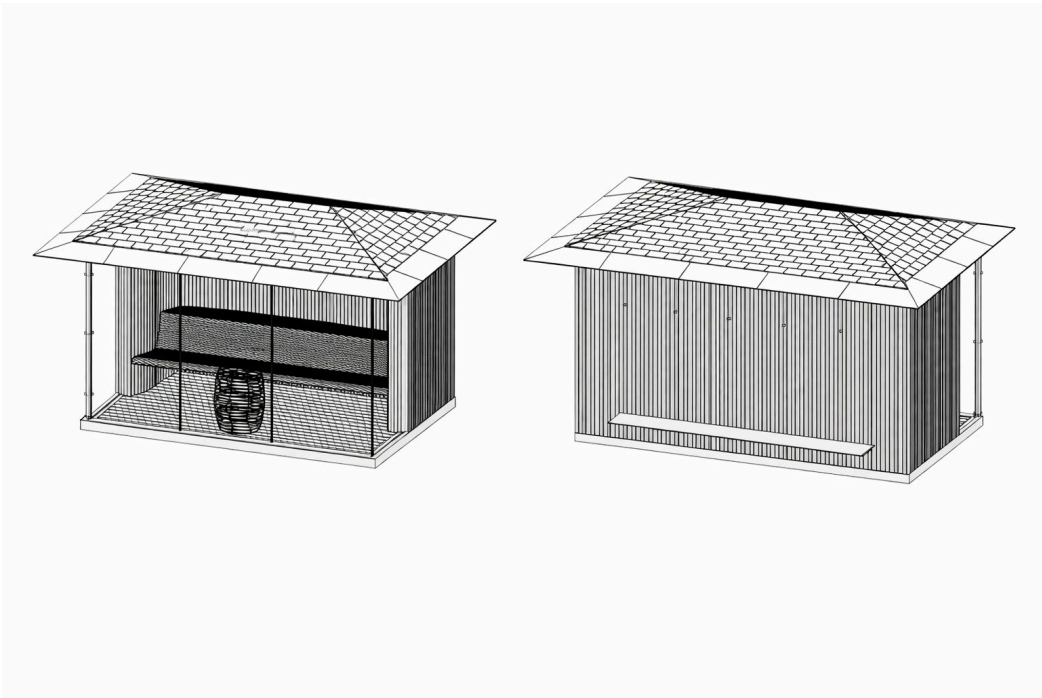

A modular sauna system — designed as a fixed set of components that adapt to any site. Outdoor units are produced in a numbered edition of 2,100, then production closes. Indoor installations are bespoke, designed to the architecture, manufactured without limitation.

Materials

Natural wood strips	Bench, back wall, and cladding in 30 x 30 mm natural colour wooden strips.
Wood planks	Floor in 100 mm wide natural colour wooden planks throughout cabin and changing room.
Black painted strips	Exterior and changing room bench in 30 x 30 mm black painted wooden strips.
Frameless glass	Load-supporting glass slabs. Panoramic wall with sliding glass door.
Powder-coated steel	Black steel wrapped bottom rim on all modules.
Slate roof	Double side pitched slate roof on main sauna module.
Stainless steel 316L	Shower hardware, marine-grade corrosion resistance.

# Seven modules

Configure to site, climate, and use.

### Sauna

The core module. Finnish sauna, panoramic glass wall, slate roof. 3300 x 2200 x 2500 mm. 4-6 persons.

### Swimming Bridge

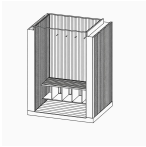
Direct water access. Black steel structure with stairs and guard rail.

### Changing Room

Skylit transitional space. Locker shelving with M4 mounting storage.

### Thermal Module

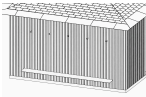
Replaces a conventional heater at the same wattage. Same heat. Also mines bitcoin.

### Outdoor Shower

Wall-mounted. Stainless steel 316L, marine-grade.

### Storage

Weather-sealed. Robes, towels, slippers.

Cold immersion basin. Single person full immersion.

### One of twentyonehundred

2,100 units. Then production closes.

A complete sauna installation for private or commercial sites — delivered and assembled on location. The cabin, changing room, and storage form the core. Swimming bridge, shower, cold plunge, and thermal module extend the configuration. Each unit receives a production number (0001-2100) stamped into the hardware.

Indoor

### The original interior design, modelled to site

Uncapped. Bespoke. Upgrade current sauna installations.

The indoor sauna features the same bench geometry, timber detailing, and material language as the outdoor unit. Each installation is shaped to the space — typically behind panoramic glass, integrated into the architecture of the building.

Suitable for residences, hotels, spas, commercial spaces, and wellness facilities.

### Process

## From interest to installation

### 01 Site Review

Submit your site through the planning tool. The tool generates a site-specific assessment.

---

### 02 Project Page

You receive a project page with your proposed configuration, M4 economics, and open questions.

---

### 03 Design Phase

We refine the configuration. Orientation, materials, finishes, heater specification. Final pricing confirmed.

---

### 04 Manufacturing

KOERNER produces the installation in Albstadt, Germany. Handcrafted, third-generation production.

---

### 05 Delivery + Installation

Modules delivered and assembled on site. Unit number assigned and stamped.
